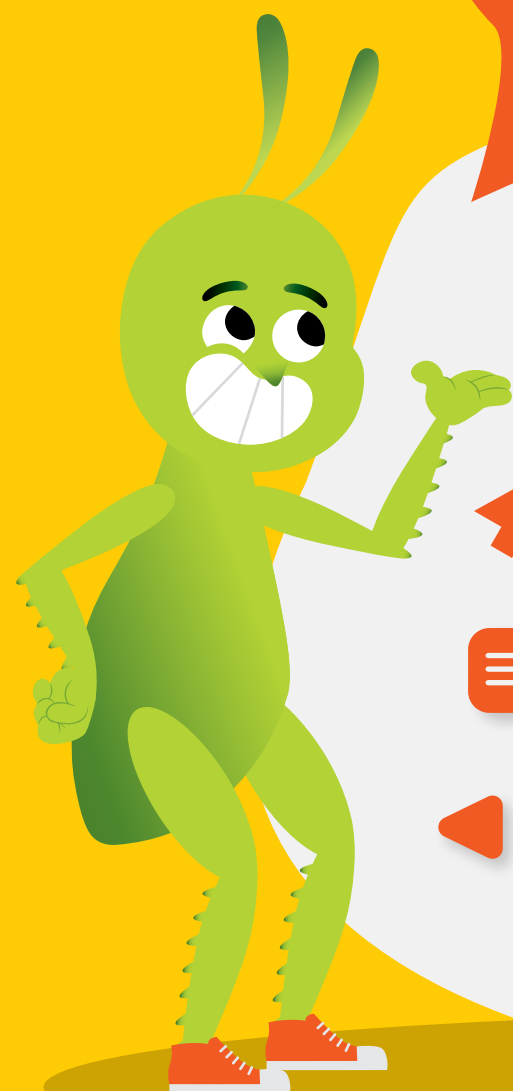

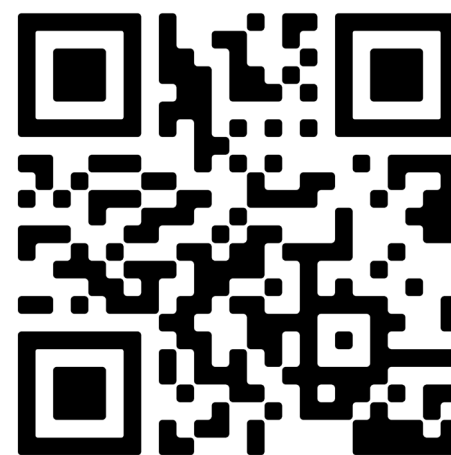

Academic Integrity

First and **foremost**, we need to run you through a little bit about academic integrity. Yes, yes, I know, but it's very important so make sure you **listen up!**

1. Collusion

Collusion - in a nutshell - is the act of getting **unauthorised help** from your mates or any third party on an assessment task. This includes file sharing to collaboratively work on sections that **aren't group tasks**.



Rookie Errors

Don't work on collaborative files with your friends!

As tempting as it is to see them thrive due to your (amazing) help, this is a **collusion breach** and could get you in trouble.

2. Plagiarism

Plagiarism means to **copy** the work of another's and claim it as your own. Believe it or not, it's also possible to plagiarise your **OWN WORK!** So make sure you're presenting authentic and original work every time, my friends.

Rookie Errors

Don't share your work with friends!

Even if your intentions are in the right place, they may plagiarise your work, putting both of you at risk of **academic infringements**.

Don't forget to reference as you go!

There's nothing worse than having to do this right when you think you're done.

3. Contract Cheating

Contract cheating is to hire a **third party** to write or complete your assessment for you. This often can have very negative extended impacts to both your student and professional career. So **BE WISE**, my friend!

Rookie Errors

Don't forget to plan plan and plan!

Planning ahead can really help you manage time and make climbing the assessment mountain that much easier. Luckily for you, **this very item** you have in your grasp will help you with just that!

4. Cheating in Exams

Cheating in exams is fairly self explanatory and includes **helping** or **receiving help** from another student in completing an exam. Make sure when you're doing an exam you **do not** receive external help!

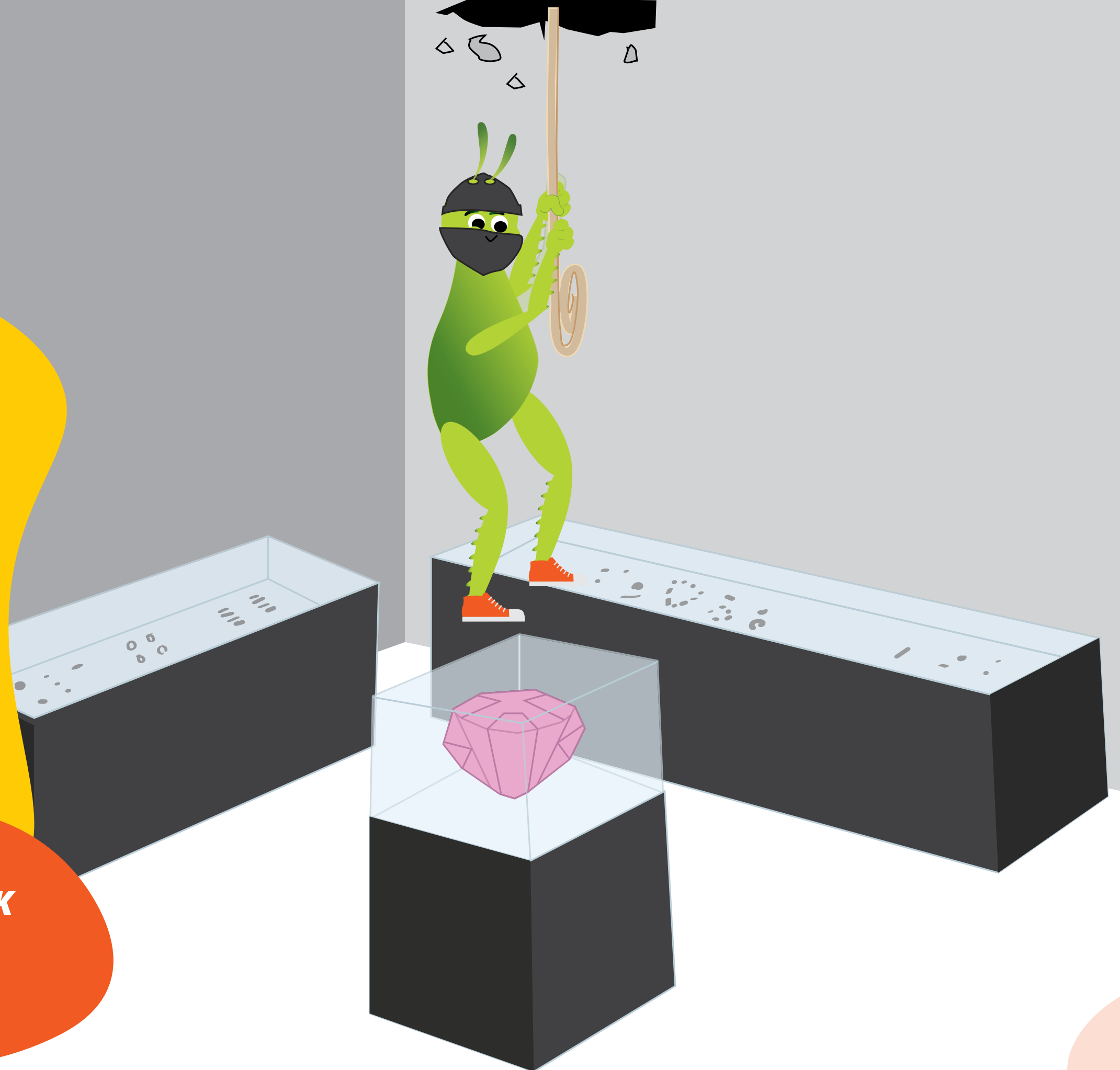

have anything to worry about!



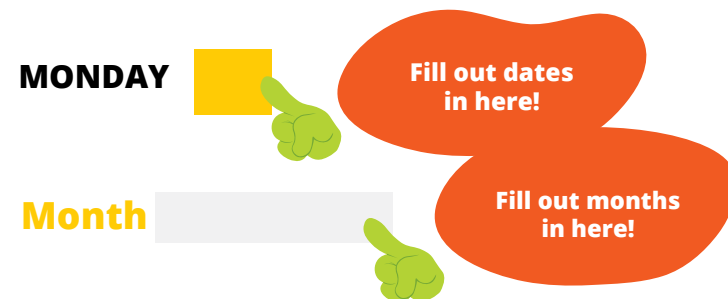

1. Chirpy's Diary Planner is organised into weeks



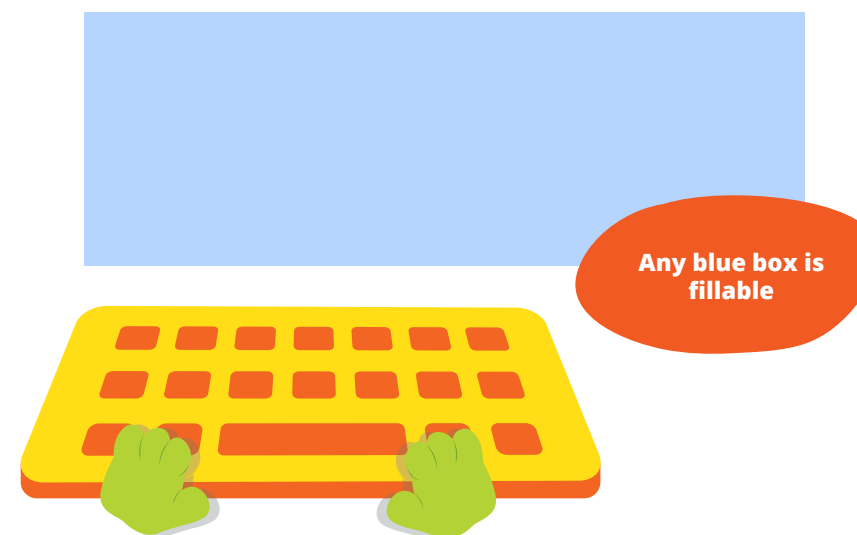
For simple usage, Chirpy's Diary Planner is organised into 12 weeks which fits *one trimester*.

2. All calendar box can be filled with information
